He also serves veterans in our community as a member of the Secretary of Veteran Affairs Advisory Committee for Minority Veterans and as a Civilian Aide to the Secretary of the Army for the State of Florida.

His work in community service has been recognized several times, including when he was selected as a “Veteran of Influence” by the Orlando Business Journal and when he was honored with the Whitney M. Young Service Award by the Boy Scouts of America.
